What Information Do We Hold About You

We will use the above information, in order to respond to your query.

If you contact us by email and telephone, we will only collect and process the personal data which you provide to us and it shall only be used for the purposes for which you provide your personal data to us. We will not retain your data or use your data for any other purpose.

How long we keep your data

We will only retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements.

For all data submitted to us via our website, we will keep your details for a period of 6 months from the date of submission. Upon expiry of that period, your data will be automatically anonymised.

Where Your Data Is Stored

Your data will be stored on our secure servers currently located with <u>one.com</u> our website domain and hosting service.

We do not transfer your data outside of the European Economic Area and use UK or European data centres.

Right to Complain

If you have any concerns about our handling of your personal data, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office ("ICO") by visiting <u>https://ico.org.uk/concerns/</u> or telephoning the ICO helpline on <u>0303</u> <u>123 1113</u>.



Your Rights

Because the data we hold about you is your data, you have the following rights in respect of the personal data we hold about you:

- 1. <u>*Right to Access*</u> this means that you can ask us for a copy of all personal data we hold about you. This enables you to receive a copy of the personal information we hold about you and to check that we are lawfully processing it.
- 2. <u>Correction Right</u> if you believe that any of the information we hold about you is incorrect or out of date, you have the right to correct such information by providing us with the correct up to date information.

In addition, you can ask us to delete the incorrect or out of date information and we will be happy to do so unless we are prevented from doing so by law or regulation.

- 3. <u>Right to be Forgotten</u> this enables you to ask us to delete or remove personal information where there is no good reason for us continuing to process it. Please note that where we are obliged to keep your personal data because of a regulatory or legal requirement, we will not be able to delete the data and must continue to retain it.
- 4. <u>*Right to Restrict Processing*</u> in some limited circumstances you have the right to restrict the processing of your data.
- 5. <u>*Right of Objection to Processing*</u> you have the right to object to us using your data for direct marketing purposes and to profiling.



- 6. <u>Right of Data Portability</u> you have the right to request a copy of the personal data we hold about you in a commonly used and machine-readable format. We can provide your data either to you or to such other third party as you specify in your request.
- 7. <u>Automated Decision-Making Objection Right</u> automated decision-making is where a decision is made entirely by technological means without human intervention. We don't use or rely on automated decision-making.
